## Code of Conduct

### Members shall:

- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every member, be they adult or child, treating everyone equally within the context of the sport.
- Provide encouragement and support to fellow members, promoting the positive aspects of the sport. Never display or condone abusive language, bullying, harassment, physical violence or any forms of behaviour that could be construed as unethical.
- Ensure all concerns of a child safeguarding nature are referred to the Welfare Officer. Ensure TRISudbury Safeguarding policy and photography policy is adhered to.
- Accept responsibility for their own behaviour. Encourage all members and parents of junior members to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and conduct.
- Take all reasonable measures to protect their own safety and the safety of others
- Compete within British Triathlon competition rules and show courtesy and respect to officials and their decisions.
- Promote the excellent reputation of TRISudbury, never bringing the club into disrepute or condoning the behaviour of others whose actions could bring the club into disrepute.
- Ensure prompt arrival to coaching sessions with the appropriate equipment. Make coaching staff aware of any new illnesses, injury or medication. If unable to attend a session cancel on the booking system.
- Ensure when attending training or competitions that appearance and behaviour are of a high standard and do not bring TRISudbury into disrepute.
- Ensure membership fees are paid promptly when requested by the membership officer and the club is informed of any name/home address/telephone/emergency contact detail changes.

## Online Code of Conduct

### Members shall:

- Not breach confidentiality by giving away personal details of individual members. Be aware of the photography policy and not share images of junior members online without prior consent of the child and their parents.
- Ensure that online communication does not bring the club into disrepute. For example making defamatory remarks about fellow members, the club or other organisations. Be mindful of what is 'Liked' or 'retweeted'
- Within the TRISudbury closed Facebook group try avoid the use of expletives or language/images that could cause offense to others and ensure suitability for all members including junior members.
- Understand that posts, comments, pictures and videos are very welcome, provided they are supportive, positive and relevant. Posts will be taken down by the page administer if they are in breach of the code of conduct.
- Ensure no comments are posted that ridicule, criticize or cause embarrassment to members or could be deemed as bullying. All comments need to be appropriate for a public arena.
